Sport Shoe Policy 2024

Sports shoes must have a sports sole (not a flat sole). They must have laces. Please note shoes cannot be canvas shoes (such as Vans, Volleys or Converse), skate shoes, gym boots or other casual footwear. The purpose of the shoe is to provide support during sporting activity. 
Parents are reminded that if you purchase a black leather sports shoe, it will be suitable for use with the normal and sports uniform as well as TAS classes. TAS classes are compulsory in Years 7 & 8 and elective subjects in Years 9 & 10. It is mandatory in TAS classes that students wear shoes with a solid leather covering on the toe.
